




Storm Recovery Update


January 26, 2024



- On the morning of December 21, 2023, a severe storm hit Port Hueneme and Oxnard, resulting in more than 6 inches of rain total, and an extremely heavy rain at approximately 1:30 a.m. that resulted in 3 inches in an hour.
- Port Hueneme has not had this much rain in an hour in over 100 years and the County has stated it's a once in 10,000 year storm.
