
Dredging Update

Harbor Federal Channel Dredging



- Dredge channel twice annually
- \$3.6M/year (Federally Funded)
- Energy & Water Appropriations Operation & Maintenance Funding
- Army Corps Managed
- 240,000CY per Year
- Deposited on East Beach
- 3-Year Contract w/Pacific Dredge
- Sandpiper All-Electric Dredge

Federal Funding Concerns



SANTA BARBARA

- Receive \$3.6M annually for two dredge cycles (240,000CY)
- Presidential Army Corps Civil Works Operations & Maintenance Budget (\$5.5B)
- FY26 Funding Removed
- Working with Congress and Senators to advocate to reinstate funding
- Have 1 funded dredge cycle left



Impacts of Not Dredging



- Safety
 - Coast Guard, Harbor Patrol, Safe Harbor
- Economic
 - \$30M Commercial Fishing, Recreation, Tourism, Cruise Ships, Beaches
- Coastal
 - Downcoast erosion, lack of sediment, property damage, beach widths, tourism



Dredging – Volumes

Harbor Channel Dredge Totals (cu yds)





West Beach Sand Bank



- Large Sediment build up in areas outside Harbor Channel
- No funding to dredge areas outside Harbor Channel
- Would like to dredge highlighted areas on West Beach and near Stearns Wharf
- Working with County of SB on potential funding source
- Permitted to dredge West Beach, just need funding
